- "Since human wisdom cannot secure us from accidents, it is the greatest effort of reason to bear them well."

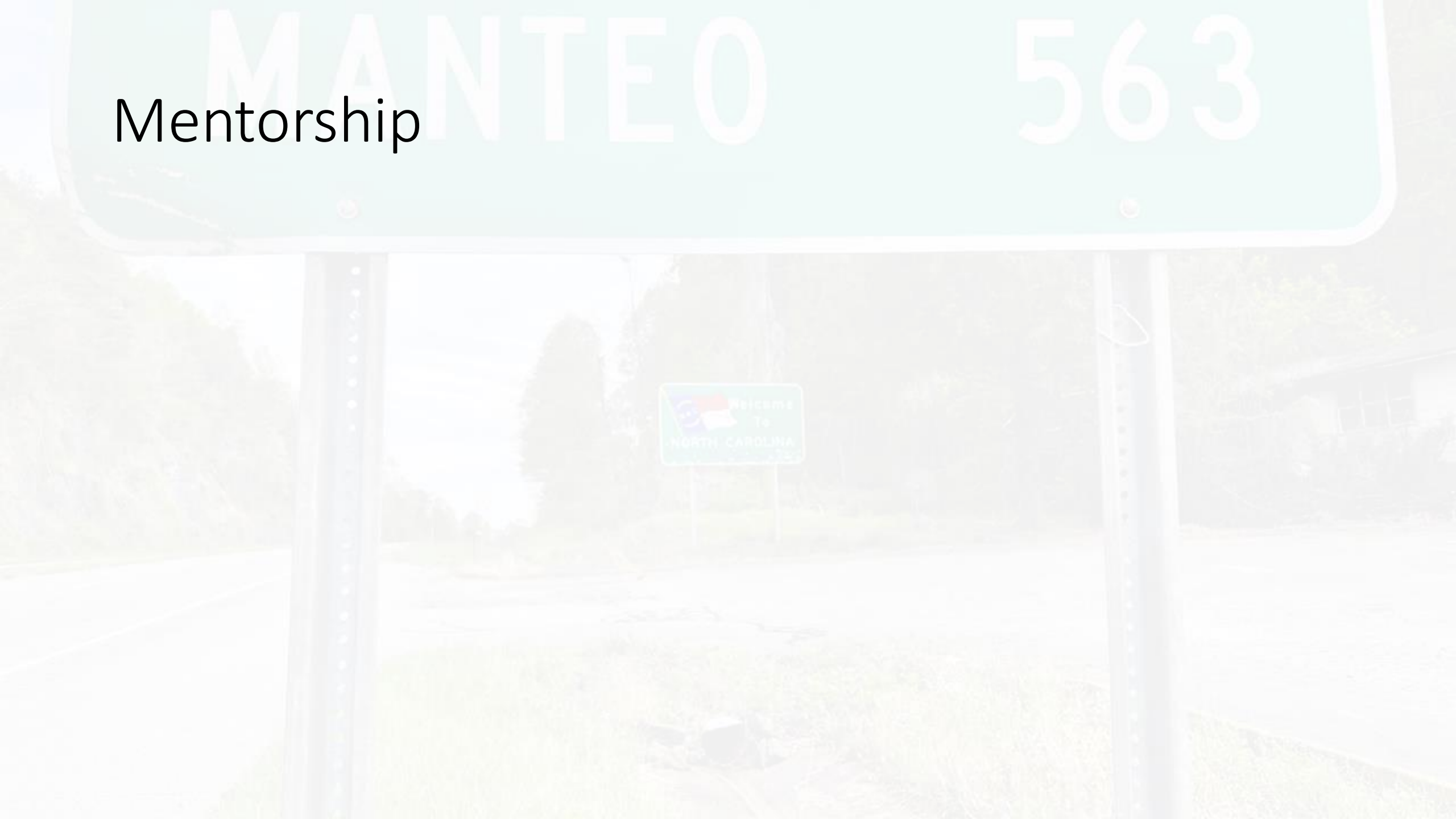
